Completing what has been a strong result for the Jesus. All about life / Christian Super V8 Ute team Fisher was extremely happy with the result.

"We had a good weekend," Fisher said. "We ran strongly across the weekend, we had issues with the new gearbox we had rebuilt before the weekend where the syncro's did not set correctly and this meant that I had problems with 3rd and 5th gear until we replaced the box with another one on the Friday night before the 3rd and final race."

"The results of an 11th in race 1, 8th in race 2 and 7th in race 3 were pleasing given that we have never been to the Indy circuit before," continued Fisher.

Phil Black General Manager of bonnet sponsor 107.3 LIFE FM was able to attend the event on the Friday for the reverse grid race and told Fisher that he could not believe the spectacle of seeing the name of Jesus in bright red letters screaming around the Surfers Paradise circuit. OK so he was pretty excited about seeing the 107.3 LIFE FM logo on the bonnet as well!

Fisher said that the track is one of the most challenging in the country, in his opinion second only to Bathurst and unfortunately in race 2 the concrete walls caught him out on a couple of occasions.

"I was pushing hard in the reverse grid race and not having 3rd gear working properly was making things really difficult, I came onto the back straight trying to carry as much speed as possible and just ran too wide and clipped the wall," Fisher said.

Fortunately Fisher was able to continue on for the rest of the weekend albeit with a few bruises on the car and was able to bring the Jesus. All about life / Christian Super V8 Ute

home in 6th place for the weekend and maintains his 5th place and leading rookie status in the Championship.

The Jesus. All about life / Christian Super Ute now makes it's way to Tasmania for a 5 day tour through the Tasmanian shopping centres as well as completing a track day where it is expected over 250 will attend. This is all part of the Jesus. All about life program that is currently running down Tasmania.
