



## Great Result for Jesus Racing Team

The Jesus Racing Team has stormed up the Yokohama V8 Ute series with a podium finish at the recent Symmons Plains Round of the 2009 Championship.

The Reverse Grid saw driver Andrew "Fishtail" Fisher make his best start of the season, passing 10 cars in all to come home in third position.

The team had to work hard between races to drop the gearbox out and inspect the clutch, where it was determined there was a problem with the slave cylinder- which had to be replaced before the next race.

With the car back intact, Race three saw Jesus Racing's best ever start- position 2 on the front row of the grid!

Andrew got a great start, as did Layton Cranbrook, and by the time they reached the 3rd corner the pair had already built up a 150m gap.

After building up a 4 second lead, on the last lap and Andrew was just .9 of a second behind Layton, before pushing hard to place pressure on Layton. However he missed a gear coming out of the hair pin and had to settle for second place in the race and the round.

The team is thrilled with the result- making it great way to bounce back after a disappointing Winton Round.

This moves the team into 8th spot on the ladder and now just 27 points off second place in the championship heading into the Darwin Round of the Series later this month.

Off the track, The Jesus Racing Team is preparing for a trip to NSW's Hunter region, where they will speak to hundreds of students at several high schools about the importance of courage.
