How to Register

1. Read the Conditions of Entry. If you agree, fill in the entry form on the back of this tear-off section.
2. **Cost—choose one of the following:**
 - Pay \$50 to register for the day; **OR**
 - Pay no registration fee, & commit to fundraising, setting a target of \$150/person (you might like to organize a group from your church!)
3. Send your completed form, with your money (cheque/money order made out to Diana Green), or your request for receipt & deposit books, to: Diana Green, 41 Galway Cres, Metford, 2323. **All registrations to be in by Tuesday, 27th April, 2010.**
4. Get your bike fixed, & start riding it!
5. Be at Maitland Park 7.30, 1st May to start the ride.



Conditions of Entry

I understand that:

- BFB involves cycling on public roads. This is an inherently dangerous activity and carries with it risk of harm and physical injury. - Bible Society NSW and Bike For Bibles accepts no responsibility for any injury to myself, or damage to any equipment or clothing I bring with me. They are not responsible for the conduct of any other participants. I am fully responsible for my own safety and welfare, as well as for my belongings.
- In the event of my accidental injury or death, or the loss or damage of any of my belongings, I hereby release Bible Society NSW, BFB, its employees, agents and volunteers, from all current and future claims for compensation. This is irrespective of possible negligence or breach of duty by employees, agents or volunteers of Bible Society NSW, or other participants in this event.
- I am entirely responsible for my own medical, hospital ambulance and other associated costs and/or treatment that may occur on my behalf.
